The Guiding Coalition member has three primary goals:

- Gain the community's support of the Circles initiative within the community and with other relevant groups
- Provide energy and resources to contribute to the Circles Initiative
- Become an expert on poverty matters creating an awareness and urgency by actively building relationships across class lines

Guiding Coalition members make a commitment of (at a minimum):

- 2 year membership commitment
- Attendance at one Guiding Coalition meeting a month
- Commitment to work on tasks between meetings (2-5 hours per month)
- Being active-and being engaged! The Circles initiative requires some involvement. It may include volunteering to attend other meetings, talking to groups, providing training.

- Strong commitment to the program and a vision for the program
- Willing to contribute work, wisdom and/or wealth to the Circles initiative
